A Covid Update

Thanks for your gracious understanding as we went back online in early January because of the surge of the Omicron variant of COVID-19. We anticipate this being a much shorter shut-down than our previous experience; however, Omicron has not yet fully subsided in our community. Rather than trying to guess at an arbitrary day to return to inperson church activities, the session has set a metric to follow much as we did in 2021. When our community's COVID-19 test positivity rate decreases below 8%, we will begin in-person activities again. As of February 1, that number was around 13%, down from 21% on January 20, so we anticipate re-opening soon. You can check covid positivity rate yourself at https://bit.ly/34cosJF. When we reach that 8% threshold and re-start in-person activities, we'll update our website and send out an email. You can also call the church office at 618-254-5880 to get more information. As always, we're committed to continuing our online worship and participation option for those unable to participate in person.

The Booth House is a homeless shelter operated by the Salvation Army inAlton. They do not have a meal prepared for them on Sundays. Six times a year we have agreed to prepare the Sunday evening meal to feed the approximately 20 people they may have. During these pandemic times, meals are dropped off and they serve themselves. Saturday Café is a ministry of First Presbyterian in Alton, serving anyone needing a meal. We handle this meal on the first Saturday of March, June, September, and December.
